Bruce and Hugo opened up their very acceptable Tohu Rewa Method Traditionelle Rose which got everyone talking very loudly, so much so that Bruce nearly broke a bottle of Tohu Whenua Matua Albarino tapping it to get some quiet. Bruce then gave us an excellent presentation of

the next Tohu Manaaki Awatere Sauvignon Blanc followed by the Tohu Matua Chardonnay. The reds followed, the Tohu Manaaki Awatere Pinot Noir, both the 2022 and the special 2021 for comparison, and finally the Tohu Riesling with dessert.



Hugo very generously offered a prize to one purchaser of 6 wines or more and Kerry Chamberlain was lucky and won 2 bottles of Tohu Pinot Noir.

ed in big reds, Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot and Cabernet Franc with some Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay to complete the range.
